Call for Proposals for Research Grant/Seed Money for PG Students

1. Purpose

The Bharathidasan University Entrepreneurship, Innovation and Career Hub (BECH-RUSA 2.0) established in July 2019 under RUSA 2.0, has set out a mission of instilling the elements of inventive innovative abilities in the scholastic educational plan and examination at the advanced education level. As a development to the students sharpening program, BECH-RUSA 2.0 welcomes applications for Research Grant/ Seed Money for Project Proposals, from Post Graduate and Under Graduate Students of Bharathidasan University Departments. This will be a plan of arrangement of Research Grant/ Seed Money as beginning capital help to empower possible new ideas prompting new products and services.

2. Eligibility / Who can apply?

The Post Graduate (Two Year Programme – III Semester; Three Year Programme – V Semester; Five Year Integrated Programme – IX Semester; Six Year Integrated Programme – XI Semester) and Under Graduate (U.G./ B.Voc – V Semester)) Students of Bharathidasan University Departments are eligible to apply for this scheme. Applicants are encouraged to submit innovative/novel project proposals preferably leading to startups/ entrepreneurship.

3. Mentor

Applicants should identify a Faculty Member of their respective Departments to be his/ her Mentor and get the Mentor's consent prior to applying for this scheme. It should be noted that not more than 5 students will be assigned to one Mentor under any circumstances.

4. Project Budget

Research Grant / Seed Money for Project Proposals of up to Rs. 15,000/- (Arts/ Management/ Languages) and Rs. 25,000/- (Sciences/ Engineering / Technology) per proposal shall be sanctioned to the Selected Project Proposals.

5. Tenure of the Project:

The tenure of the Project shall be One year from the date of sanction of the Project.

6. Mode of Application and Selection of Project Proposals

- The call for application regarding the Research Grant/Seed Money is notified through the circulars and websites <u>https://bechrusa.in</u> and <u>www.bdu.ac.in</u>
- Applicants should submit the Project Proposal in online.
- Applicants should submit an endorsement letter duly endorsed by the Head of the Department and the Mentor along with the Project Proposal.
- A Scrutinizing Committee will scrutinize the Students' Applications/ Project Proposals and the selected Students will be called for a presentation and interview with a Selection Committee which will assess the Project Proposals on several key qualitative and quantitative factors.
- The selected Project Proposals by the Selection Committee will be awarded the Research Grant/Seed Money (The decision of the Selection Committee will be final.).

7. Documents Required

- a) Updated Resume (Download Template)
- b) Qualification Certificates
- c) Age proof Certificate
- d) Category Certificate (in case of Age Relaxation)
- e) Undertaking certificate by the applicant (Download Template)
- f) Consent letter from Mentor (Download Template), if applicable
- g) Brief CV of the Mentor (Download Template), if applicable

8. General Conditions / Exit Policy

- 1. The project approved to students is not transferable to other students in any case.
- 2. Not more than one Project Proposal is allowed per student.
- 3. The Project duration is one year and should be closely worked with the mentor/supervisor to accomplish the objectives of the Project Proposal.
- 4. The student who wish to perform part of his/ her studies in Intra-Department/ National Laboratories may be permitted with approval as per University norms.
- 5. No extension in tenure is permissible under any circumstances.
- 6. A final report must be submitted to the BECH-RUSA 2.0, a week before the closing date of the project, which has to be endorsed by the respective Mentors and Heads of the Departments.
- 7. All equipment purchased under this scheme should be handed over to the respective Departments on completion of the project.
- 8. No objection certificate must be obtained by the student from BECH-RUSA 2.0 duly endorsed by the respective Mentors and Heads of the Departments on completion of the project.
- 9. The project work must be presented in Seminar/Review Committee /Tech Platform/ Hackathon.
- 10. In case any student fails to complete the project, he/she has to refund the Research Grant/Seed Money to BECH-RUSA 2.0.
